

## Great specimen tree for limited space

Here is a very interesting plant that has really caught my eye. The Taxodium distichum 'Peve Minaret' is a dwarf Bald Cypress that grows very slowly, ultimately reaching 10 ft tall and 4-5 ft wide. The dense bright green foliage is outstanding. If you like Bald Cypress, you will love these. The Common Bald Cypress is like a St. Bernard puppy, cute and manageable when young but grows rapidly, overtaking most residential landscapes.



This would be a great specimen or accent piece for a limited area. I have seen one of these in a landscape and it has added 1 ft of growth in the last 5 years. It prefers full sun and moist soil but can tolerate dry upland to wet aquatic conditions. Fall color is a reddish brown and some foliage may persist through the winter.
