



Fruiting Apples for the Urban Setting

Your clients want to join the ever growing trend of edible gardening, and want a couple of fruiting apples in their landscape, but their lot is the size of a postage stamp. Semi-dwarf fruit trees will even prove to be too large for this site, besides that your customer really does not like to prune, so what do you have to offer them?

We'll check these out, a new series of dwarf columnar apples from Garden Debut. The Urban Series of apples gets only 8-10' tall and about 2' wide at maturity. They come in four great colors, Tasty Red, Blushing Delight, Golden Treat and Tangy Green. Fruit is borne on short branches along the main stem. You can expect full sized fruit the first year as long as you plant two or more to provide the necessary cross pollination.



Plant them in limited space or in large pots on your patio or deck. Nothing better than having a couple of trees full of fruit sitting there to pick on your beautiful new patio, as you are relaxing after a hard day at work. So check them out and plant a couple. This year they will be available in #5 and #7 pots. If they are like any of the other fruits this year do not expect them to last long. So plant and let your clients enjoy the "fruits" of their labor.
