



## Summer snowflakes?

I would like to tell you about this viburnum. It has an unusually long blooming period. Starting in late spring with a lot of flowers, it will continue to bloom lightly through the summer and into the fall. This is *Viburnum plicatum tomentosum* 'Summer Snowflake'.



The fall color is a nice bronze-purple, and it will get red berries. Sometimes it is still blooming in September. It needs full sun to part shade, and is a low maintenance, dwarf variety. It will mature to 5-8' tall but can be kept smaller with pruning.

Give this plant a try, I think your customers will like it.
