



Acer japonicum 'Acontifolium' Fernleaf Full-Moon Maple

The Fernleaf Full-Moon Maple is a great small-growing specimen tree. It eventually grows 10' tall and wide with very distinct, fern-like palmate leaves. Bright green leaves emerge in spring followed by subtle red flowers. It has larger leaves than most Japanese Maples that enhance



the stunning fall color, starting yellow then turning a crimson red. This native to Japan & Korea evolved as an understory tree and fits in perfectly along a woodland edge making an excellent focal point. Very easy to grow in average well drained soil.

This tree is somewhat rare in the local landscape and an excellent alternative to the typical redleaf Acer palmatum cultivars. We have a few nice selections for sale at a very reasonable price. Add a little sophistication to your installations. This tree is sure to become your customer's favorite plant.
