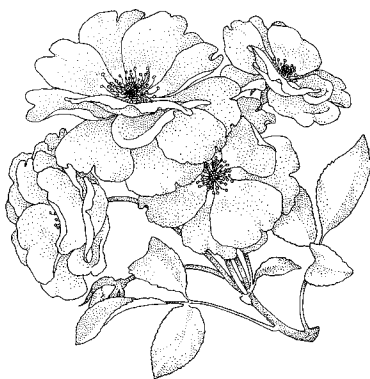

## VINES

---

Woody vines, twining or clinging - all are winter hardy and prefer a support to ramble on. Grow vines on trellises, fences, trees, or arbors. Plan ahead, some have very vigorous growth habits!

### **Actinidia - Hardy Kiwi** ○●

---

Twining vine. Sexes are separate, needing both male and female plants for pollination, except 'Issai'. Edible fruit.

arguta 'Issai': Self pollinator 20'

### **Akebia - Fiveleaf Akebia** ○●

---

Fast to establish tough vine with unusual leaf texture. White flowers late March. No fall color.

quinata 'Variegata': Pink flws, lvs splashed white.

### **Ampelopsis - Porcelainberry** ○●

---

Unusual fruit color, berries change from green to lilac to amethyst purple, effective Sept-Oct. Twining vine with lots of tendrils. Prune late winter-early spring.

brevipenduncula: 'Elegans': lvs splashed white. 10-15'

### **Aristolochia - Dutchman's Pipe** ○●

---

Vigorous twining habit, large leaves form a solid screen. Unusual yellow-green flowers in May or June.

macrophylla (durior) 20-30'

### **Campsis - Trumpet Vine** ○●

---

Large, tubular flowers a favorite of hummingbirds. Fast growing vine clings by root-like holdfasts. Grows anywhere.

---

Stunning white flowers late June-July. Very tolerant of pollution, urban conditions, cold, and shade. Clings by holdfasts.

## **Lonicera - Climbing Honeysuckle**



Twining, clambering vine - vigorous to invasive. Flowers quite fragrant.

x heckrottii 'Gold Flame': Pink & yellow flowers. 10-15'

## **Polygonum - Silver Lace Vine**



Vigorous twining vine. Adaptable, will grow where others won't. Very cold hardy.

## **Schizophragma - Japanese Hydrangea-vine**



Similar to climbing hydrangea, but growing flatter to the wall it climbs on. Flowers slightly later (late June-July) and is a little less cold hardy. True clinging vine.

hydrangeoides: White, slightly drooping flws. 20-30'

## **Wisteria**



Stout twining vine, can be trained into a tree form. Distinctive long racemes of flowers drip from the vines in April-May. Can be difficult to get to bloom, but worth the wait. Japanese (floribunda) twines clockwise; Chinese (sinensis) twines counter-clockwise.

floribunda - Japanese: Blue, purple or white, mid May. 35'

Water Plantain. Shoreline to 10" deep, will range deeper and can be submerged. 2-3' tall, flower white.

### ***Eleocharis palustris* (E. smallii)** **N**

Creeping Spike Rush. Grows in dense clumps along shorelines (1-2" deep). 1-2' tall.

### ***Iris versicolor*** **N**

---

Blue Flag. Shoreline to 3" deep. 2-3' tall, flower purplish.

### ***Iris virginica* var. *shrevei*** **N**

---

Southern Blue Flag. Boggy to 3" deep. Flower violet with yellow & white, to 2' tall.

### ***Juncus effusus*** **N**

---

Soft Rush. Tolerates a wide variety of conditions. 2-4' tall. Will grow in up to 3" of water.

### ***Juncus torreyi*** **N**

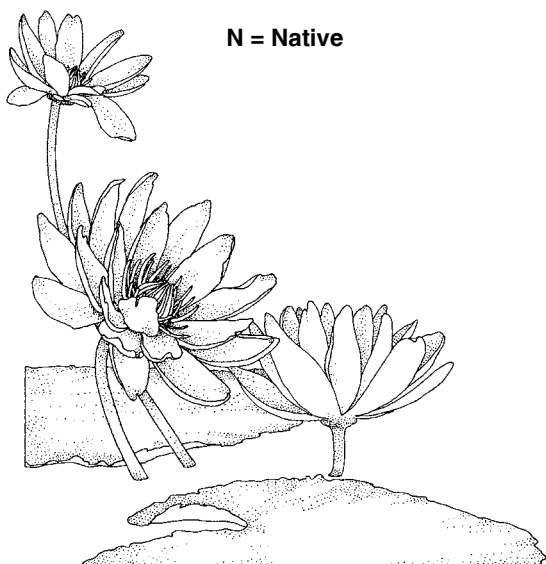

Torrey's Rush. Lowlands, wet soil. Ornamental seed heads. Waterfowl food, 10-30" tall.

### ***Nuphar lutea* var. *advena*** **N**

---

Yellow Water Lily, Spatterdock. Floater, flower yellow.



***Nymphaea odorata*** **N**

---

Water Lily. Floater, flower white.

***Polygonum amphibium (P. coccineum)*** **N**

---

Marsh Smartweed. Shoreline to 18" deep. Red flowers. Plant 1000 per acre. Withstands flooding and drought.

***Pontederia cordata*** **N**

---

Pickerel Plant. Fresh or slightly brackish water 1-3' deep. Showy blue flowers. 2-3' tall. Plant 3-4' apart.

***Potamogeton nodosus (P. americanus)*** **N**

---

Longleaf Pond Plant. Grows in water 1-5' deep, depending on water clarity. Plant 1000 per acre.

***Potamogeton pectinatus*** **N**

---

Sago Pond Plant. Grows in water 1-5' deep, depending on water clarity. Plant 1000 per acre. Excellent duck food.

***Potamogeton richardsonii*** **N**

---

Redhead Grass. Grows in water 1-5' deep, depending on water clarity. Plant 1000 per acre. Feeds ducks and fish.

***Sagittaria latifolia*** **N**

---

Arrowhead, Wapato Duck Potato. Shoreline to 1.5' deep. Withstands fluctuating water levels. 1000 per acre. White.

***Sagittaria rigida*** **N**

---

Deep Water Duck Potato. 1-3' deep. Withstands fluctuating water levels. 1000 per acre. Excellent waterfowl food.

***Scirpus atrovirens*** **N**

---

Green Bulrush. Erosion control. Moist muck or peat soil to shallow water. Will tolerate periods of drought. 3-4'.

***Scirpus cyperinus*** **N**

---

Woolgrass. Moist soil to shallow water. Clump-forming to 3-5' tall. Ornamental fuzzy seedheads.

**Shoenoplectus acutus (Scirpus acutus) N**

Hardstem Bulrush. Erosion control, stands wave action. Grows 4-5' tall in 0 to 3' of water. 1000 per acre.

**Shoenoplectus fluviatilis (Scirpus fluviatilis) N**

River Bulrush. Large aggressive grower for tough sites. Erosion control, tolerates fluctuating water levels. Moist shoreline to 1' deep water. Plant 1000 per acre. 4-7' tall.

**Shoenoplectus pungens (Scirpus americanus) N**

Threesquare Bulrush. Grows 4' tall, likes sandy shorelines. Moist soil to 2' deep fresh, or slightly salty water.

**Shoenoplectus tabernaemontana (Scirpus validus) N**

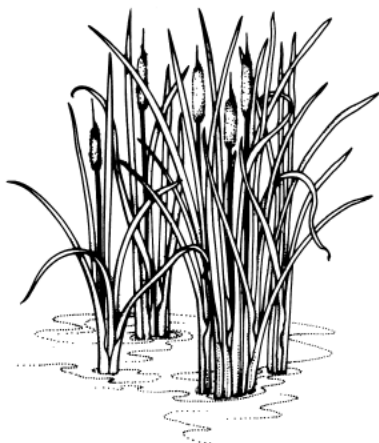
Softstem Bulrush. Taller but more delicate than Hardstem Bulrush. Moist shoreline to 1' of water, in a protected location. Grows 4-8' tall.

**Sparganium eurycarpum N**

Bur Reed. Rush-like growth 2-4' tall, survives flooding and drought. Moist soils to 1.5' of water. Fine duck and muskrat food, erosion control. Plant 1000 per acre.

**Typha angustifolia & latifolia N**

Cattail. Moist shoreline to 1' of water. Plant 1000 per acre.
